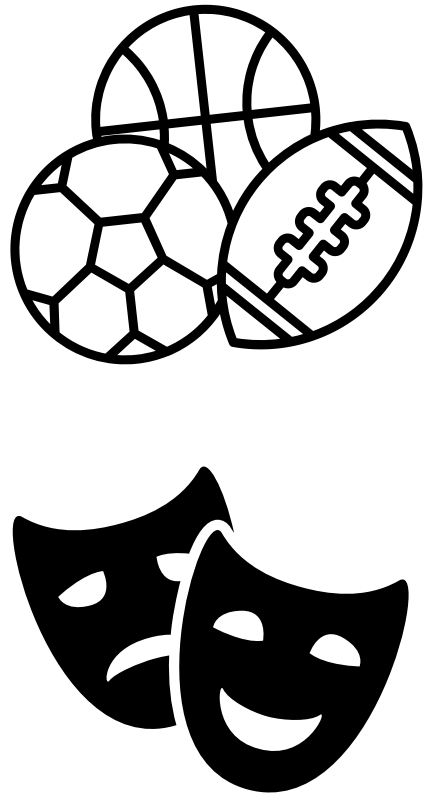


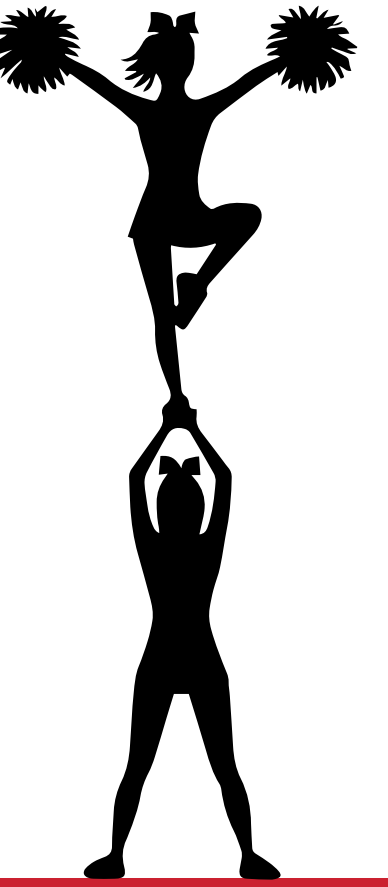


EVERY DAY COUNTS EXTRACURRICULAR ATTENDANCE EXPECTATIONS



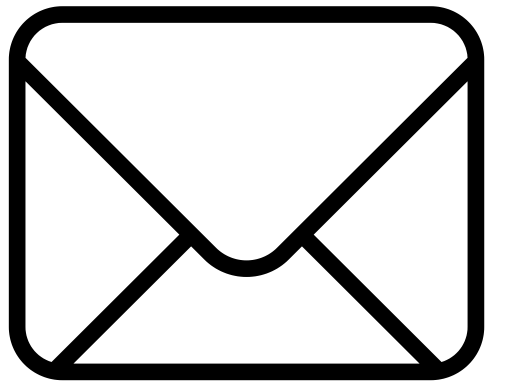
ABSENCES AND TARDIES

A student who is absent (excused or unexcused) and/or excessively tardy (10 minutes or more) for more than two scheduled blocks may not actively participate in their extracurricular activity that day.



COMMUNICATION AND ACTIVE PARTICIPATION

Students are expected to communicate with their coach/sponsor when absences occur. If a student is at school but does not meet the threshold to participate, they may attend their extracurricular activity but are not permitted to actively participate.



College visits, bereavement leave, religious observances, field trips and extenuating circumstances (when approved by the Assistant Principal for Student Supports) will not count against participation in their extracurricular activity.



EXCEPTIONS



ACTIVITIES TIED TO GRADES AND COURSES

A co-curricular experience connected to a course and grade, such as a curricular-based music performance, carries attendance and participation expectations. Therefore, those co-curricular experiences are exempt from this requirement.
